About Second Harvest Food Bank

Based in Silicon Valley, Second Harvest Food Bank of Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties is one of the largest food banks in the nation. Currently providing food to an average of 260,000 people every month, Second Harvest is a trusted community-based organization that was founded in 1974. Despite the immense wealth in Silicon Valley, and partly due to the high cost of living, hunger and malnutrition are pervasive. The Food Bank distributes nutritious food, including more fresh produce than almost any other food bank in the country, through a network of 309 nonprofit partners at 985 sites. Second Harvest is pursuing innovative efforts to increase access to food resources as it seeks to feed more hungry people each month. To reach more people, it advocates for anti-hunger policies and connects those in need to federal nutrition programs and other food resources. About the Position

We are hiring a Director of Community Nutrition to lead our Nutrition Department, one of the most robust and innovative food bank nutrition education programs in the country. The Department consists of the Director, three Nutrition Education Managers, and around 60 Health Ambassador nutrition volunteers all of whom teach about 40,000 clients a year. As the Director, you will be responsible for the following:

- The strategic direction of the department and deepening our impact
- Ensuring that the food we distribute is as healthy and safe as possible
- Overseeing the nutrition education program to teach clients about nutrition so they are excited to receive healthy food, know how to prepare it, and develop and maintain healthy dietary habits for life

The department does a wide range of activities, from implementing the Healthy Food & Beverage Policy to nutrition education, including on-site distribution education, food samples, cooking demonstrations, six-week workshops, and creating nutrition outreach materials, such as our cooking videos, client-facing Facebook page, posters, and tip cards.
